What symptoms might we consider to rule in the TMJ?

- Patient point to TMJ (highly sensitive and specific)
- Joint noise (on opening, closing, reciprocal, unilateral or bilateral)
- Joint locking
- Limited opening, trouble eating, chewing
- Ear symptoms such as tinnitus, fullness, or loss of hearing acuity
- Dizziness
- Headaches
- Neck pain
- Bruxism, sleep position (hands under chin), playing musical wind instruments
- Dental sings and symptoms
- Psychosocial factors
